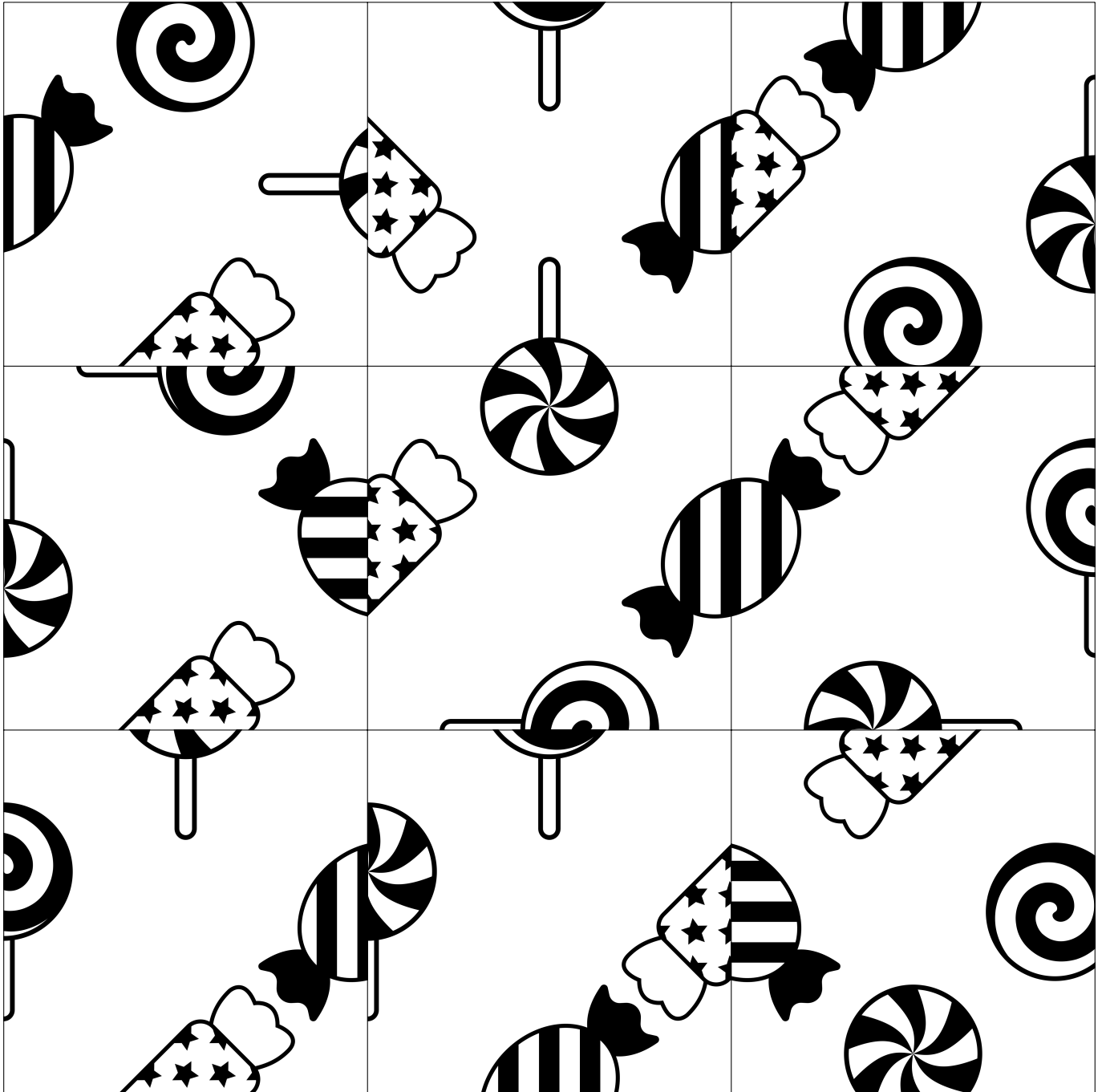


CANDY PUZZLE

Cut apart the pieces below and assemble them into a 3 x 3 grid so that the puzzle pieces match along each edge.

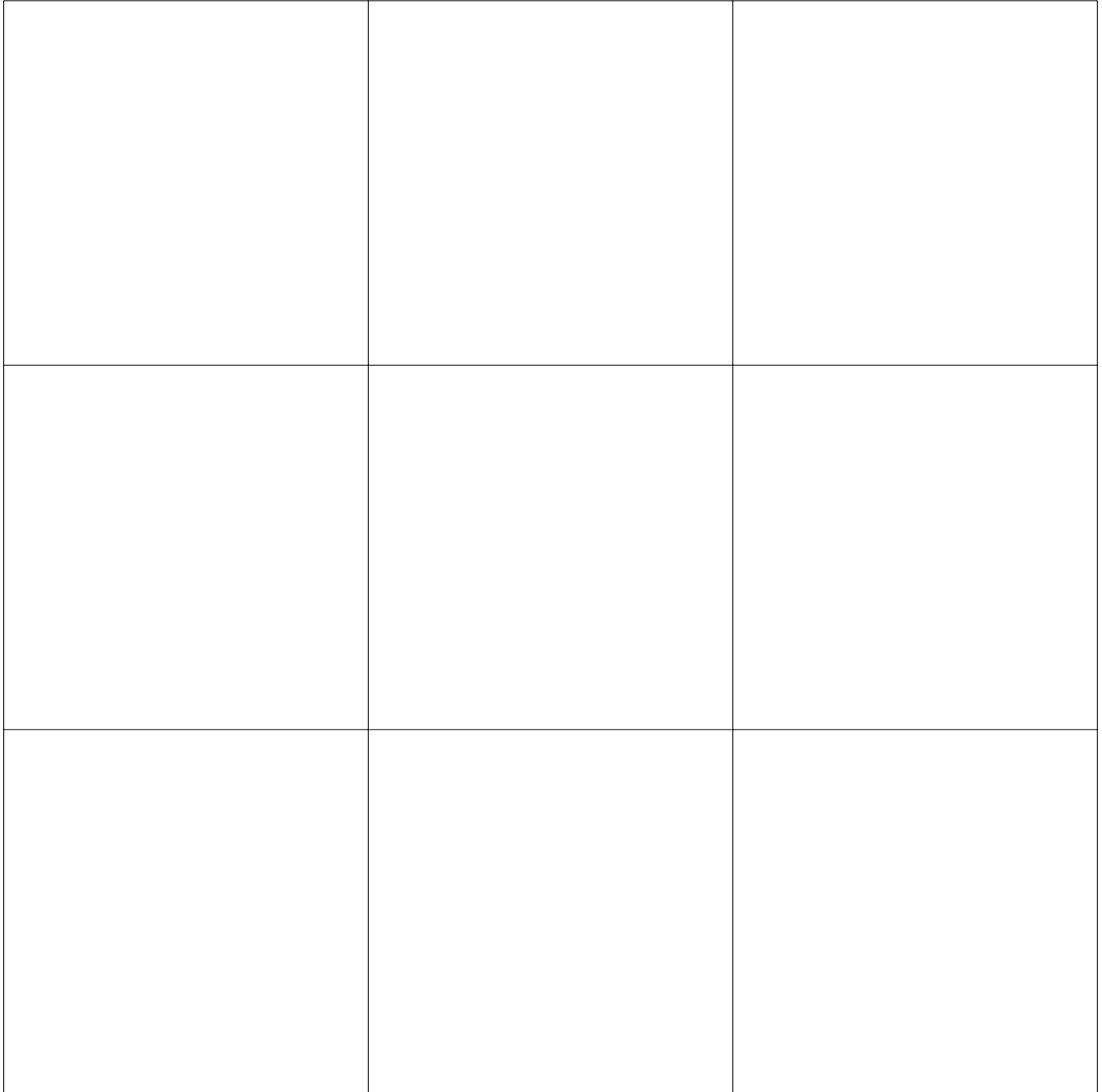

Assemble the puzzle pieces on the grid below so the pictures match up along each edge to form images of candy.

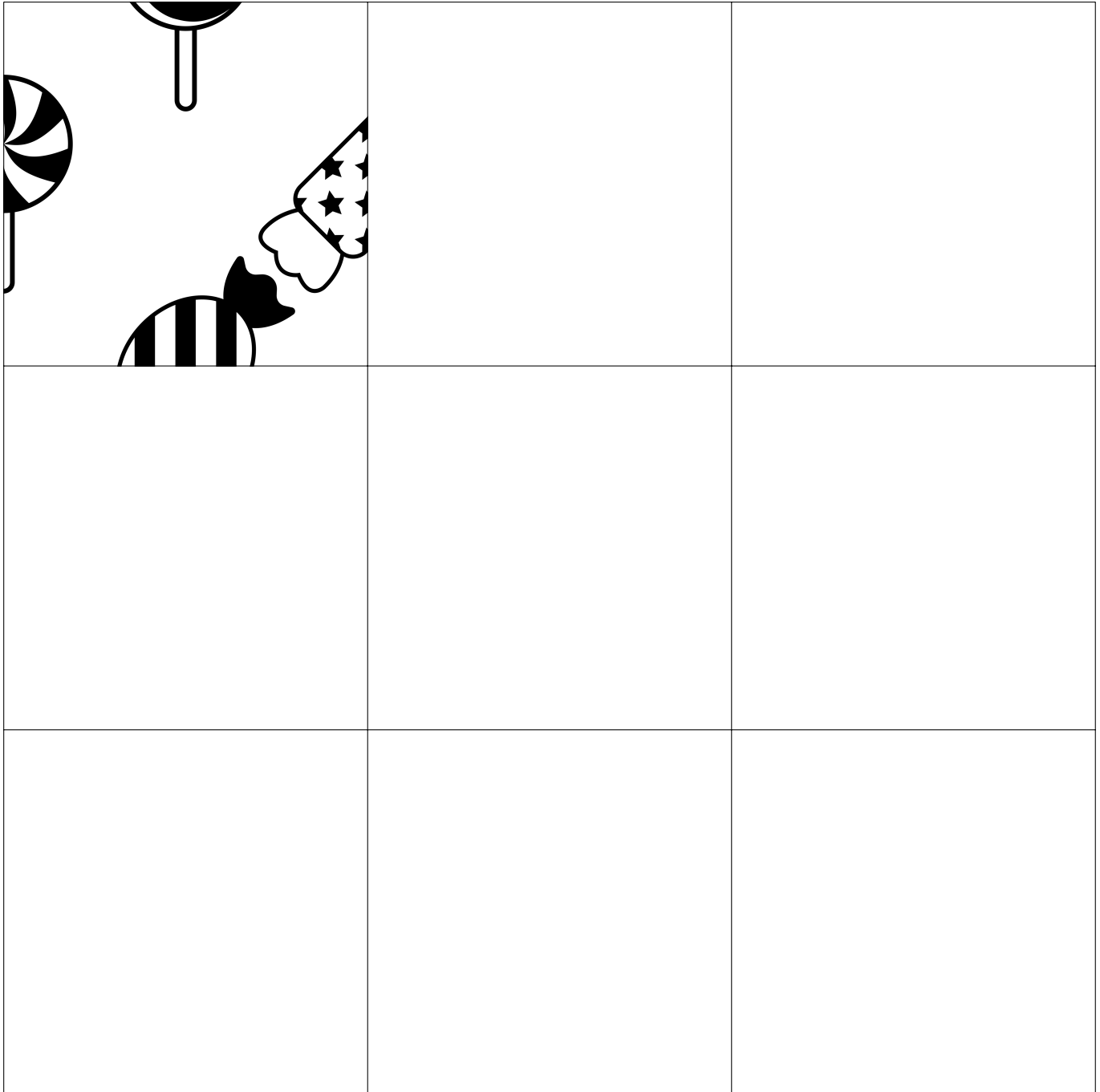
