

NUMERICAL TIC-TAC-TOE

Odds (1, 3, 5, 7, 9) vs Evens (2, 4, 6, 8)

Player 1 plays with odds. Player 2 plays with evens. Odds always go first. On your turn, place one of your numbers on the tic-tac-toe board. Each number can only be used once. The winner is the first player to complete a line (horizontal, vertical, or diagonal) with a sum of 15. The line may contain both even and odd numbers.

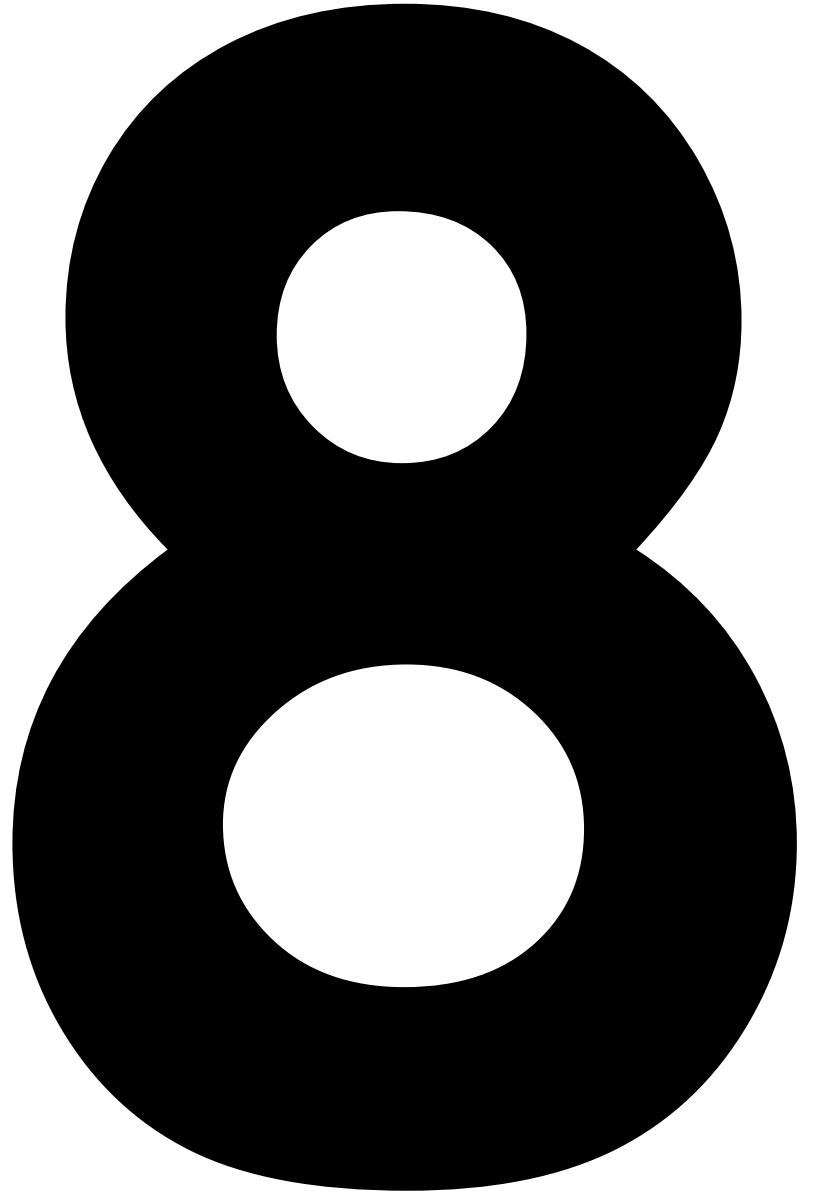



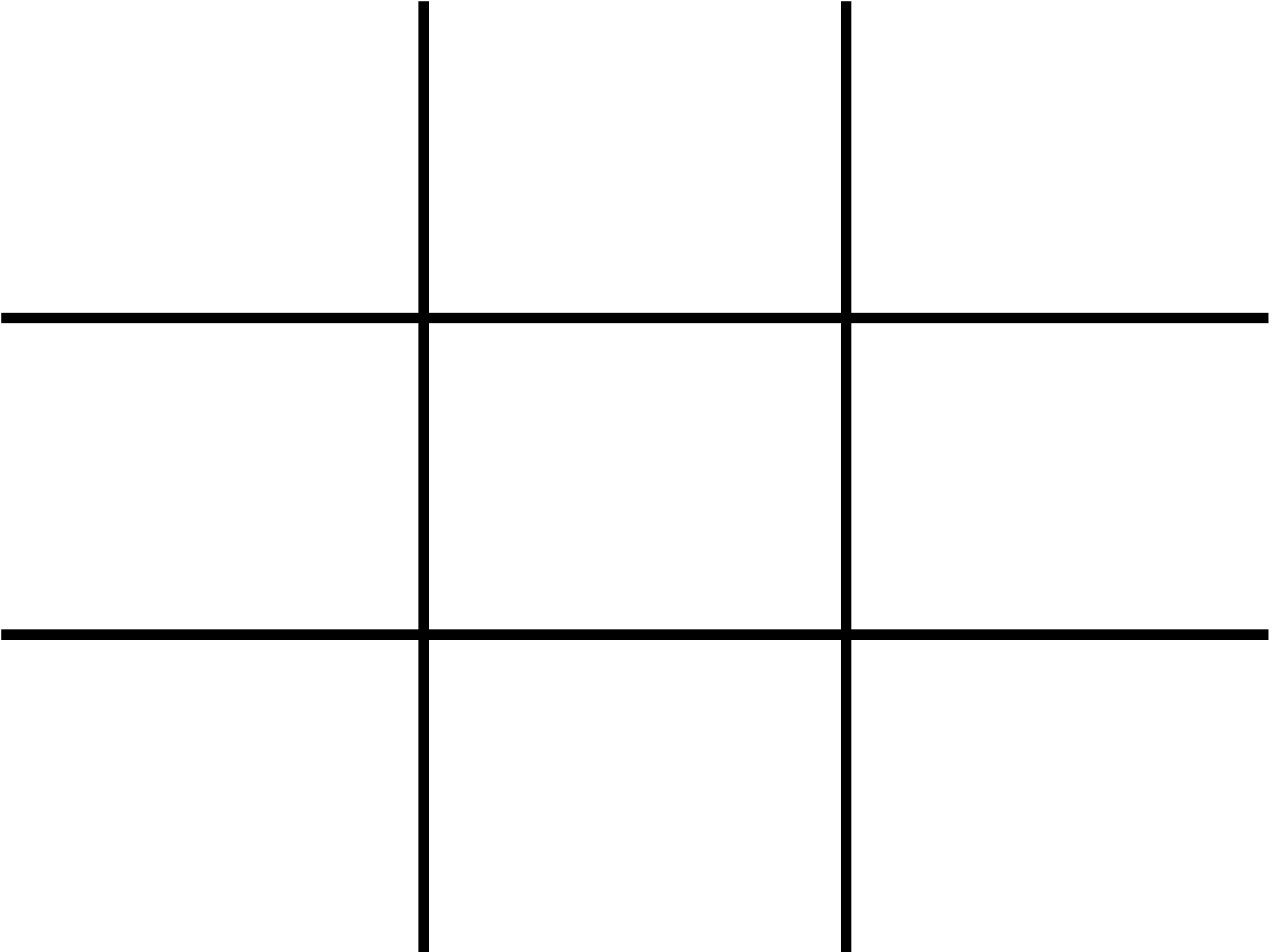
