

## **Finding Sine, Cosine, and Tangent of a Point**

1. Graph the point on the coordinate plane.
2. Draw a line connecting the point to the origin.
3. Draw an additional line perpendicular to the x-axis to complete the reference triangle.
4. Label the reference angle as  $\theta$ .
5. Label the lengths of the triangle's legs.
6. Use the Pythagorean Theorem to find the length of the hypotenuse.
7. Find  $\sin(\theta)$ ,  $\cos(\theta)$ , and  $\tan(\theta)$ .

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
